

# Required Immunizations for 2020-2021 School Year



## Pre-Kindergarten

DTP/DTaP/DT *	<b>4 Doses</b> (with 1 dose given on or after the 4th birthday)
IPV (Polio)*	<b>3 Doses</b> (with 1 dose given on or after the 4th birthday)
MMR*	<b>1 Dose</b> (given on or after the 1st birthday) OR serologic confirmation of immunity.
HIB	<b>3 Doses</b> (with at least 1 dose given on or after the 1st birthday) Not required on or after 5 yrs of age.
Hepatitis A*	<b>2 Doses</b> (1st dose given on or after 1st birthday and <b>2nd Dose</b> given 6 months apart) OR serologic confirmation of immunity.
Hepatitis B	<b>3 Doses</b> OR serologic confirmation of immunity.
Varicella*	<b>1 Dose</b> (given after 1st birthday), OR written validation from parent or doctor of an approximate date of disease, OR serologic confirmation of immunity.
PCV	<b>3 Doses</b> (given in infancy with 1 dose on or after after 1st birthday) Not required after 5 years of age.

## Kindergarten through Sixth Grade

DTP/DTaP/DT/Td/Tdap*	<b>5 Doses</b> (with 1 dose given on or after the 4th birthday) OR <b>4 Doses</b> (if the 4th dose was given on or after the 4th birthday) OR <b>3 Doses</b> if student is 7 yrs of age or older (at least 1 dose given on or after the 4th birthday).
IPV (Polio)*	<b>4 Doses</b> (with 1 dose given on or after 4th birthday) OR <b>3 Doses</b> (if the 3rd dose was given on or after the 4th birthday)
MMR*	<b>2 Doses</b> (with the 1st dose given on or after the 1st birthday) OR serologic confirmation of immunity.
Hepatitis B	<b>3 Doses</b> OR serologic confirmation of immunity.
Varicella*	<b>2 Doses</b> (with the 1st dose given on or after the 1st birthday) OR written validation from a parent or doctor of approximate date of disease, OR serologic confirmation of immunity.
Hepatitis A*	<b>2 Doses</b> (with the 1st dose given on or after the 1st birthday).

\* Doses given up to (and including) 4 days before the birthday will meet the requirements for school entry. Exclusions from compliance are allowable on an individual basis as specified in Texas Education Code 2.09, Chapter 97. For further information, contact the school nurse.

## SECONDARY

### 8th - 12th Grade

### 7th Grade

DTP/DTaP/DT/Td**	<b>5 Doses</b> ( <b>3 Doses</b> if student was 7 yrs of age or older when vaccine started).
Tdap*	<b>1 Dose</b> (entering 7th grade)
IPV (Polio)*	<b>4 Doses</b> (with <b>1 Dose</b> given on or after 4th birthday); <b>3 Doses</b> (if 3rd dose received after 4th birthday)
MMR*	<b>2 Doses</b> (with the <b>1st Dose</b> given on or after the 1st birthday), OR serologic confirmation of immunity
Hepatitis B	<b>3 Doses</b> OR serologic confirmation of immunity.
Varicella*	<b>2 Doses</b> (with the <b>1st dose</b> given on or after the 1st birthday), OR written validation from a parent or doctor of approximate date of disease, OR serologic confirmation of immunity
Meningococcal*	<b>1 Dose</b> (entering 7th grade).
Hepatitis A*	<b>2 Doses</b> (with the <b>1st dose</b> given on or after the 1st birthday)

DTP/DTaP/DT/Td/Tdap*	<b>4 Doses</b> ( <b>3 Doses</b> if student is 7 yrs of age or older when vaccine started); a dose of Tdap is required when 10 years have passed for 8th – 12th grade; Td is acceptable in place of Tdap if a medical contraindication to pertussis exists.
IPV (Polio)*	<b>4 Doses</b> (with <b>1 Dose</b> given on or after 4th birthday).
Measles, Mumps, Rubella*	<b>2 Doses</b> (first dose given on after 1st birthday) and may be listed as MMR.
Hepatitis B	<b>3 Doses</b> OR serologic confirmation or immunity.
Varicella*	<b>2 Doses</b> (given after 1st birthday), OR written validation from parent or doctor of an approximate date of disease, OR serologic confirmation of immunity.
Hepatitis A*	<b>2 Doses</b> (with the 1st dose given on or after the 1st birthday)
Meningococcal*	<b>1 Dose</b> required (booster dose between 16-18 yrs. Recommended).

**Quick Fact for Texas Residents:** A signed affidavit must be presented by the child's parent or legal guardian, stating that the child's parent or legal guardian declines vaccinations for reasons of conscience, including because of the person's religious beliefs. The affidavit will be valid for a two-year period. The child, who has not received the required immunizations for reasons of conscience, including religious beliefs, may be excluded from school in times of emergency or epidemic declared by the commissioner of public health. Medical exemptions are allowed as are exemptions for active duty members of the United States armed forces.

*Provisional:* "All immunizations should be completed by the first date of attendance. The law requires that students be fully vaccinated against the specified diseases." A student may enroll in school provisionally, if the student has received at least one dose of each specified age-appropriate vaccine. In order to remain enrolled the student must complete the required subsequent doses of each vaccine within 30 days from enrollment. "If, at the end of the 30-day period, a student has not received a subsequent dose of vaccine, the student is not in compliance and the school shall exclude the student from school attendance until the required dose is administered" according to the Texas Department of State Human Services.

\* Doses given up to (and including) 4 days before the birthday will meet the requirements for school entry. \*\*If any combination of four doses of OPV and IPV was received before four years of age, an additional dose is required. Exemption are those students age 18 years and over. Exclusions from compliance are allowable on an individual basis as specified in Texas Education Code 2.09, Chapter 97. For further information, contact the school nurse.
